Directions to Ogden Community Garden

- 1. From I-19 Sahuarita Road exit, head east for 2.3 miles.
- 2. Turn south onto S Santa Rita Road.
- 3. After 0.2 mile turn left onto an unpaved road. Watch for signs for the garden.
- 4. The garden is 0.1 mile on the right.
